Stonyhurst connection to D-day



Lester Guilly SJ (OS 1923) rose to be senior chaplain in the second world war. He boasted later in life that he was one of only 6 people to know the date, time and place of the D-day landing. It was his job to mobilise the chaplains (including 80 Jesuits) to follow the troops as they advanced across Europe. He was awarded the OBE

and mentioned in dispatches.

After the war he was sent out to Guyana, where he served 6 years as mission superior and then as the first Bishop of Georgetown.

He died in St Lucia one day after the 50th anniversary of the D-day landings.
