#### Fr Tim – health update

Fr Tim has been diagnosed with an aggressive form of prostate cancer. The nuclear body scan revealed that the cancer has not spread to the bones or lymph nodes – which is good news. He has now begun a course of Hormone Therapy, designed to shrink the tumour. In about 3 months' time he will have to undergo some radio beam therapy, which is likely to have some side effects. For the time being, at least, he can continue with his schedule of Masses, weddings, baptisms etc. However, further down the line, he may have to replace some Masses with communion services.
