Coming to St Peter's for Mass:

Please adhere to the following guidelines:

- + Do not come to church if you are unwell, self-isolating, shielding or returning from a country where you have to quarantine
- + You should wear a face covering
- + Sanitise your hands on the way in and way out
- + Observe the one way system
- + Observe social distancing – make sure there is an empty bench between you and anyone else in the Church and keep away from the centre aisle.
- + Any printed materials you touch (Newsletters etc) place in a bin or take home with you.
- + Observe social distancing as you come into church, as you come forward for communion and, very importantly as you leave the church.

If you are driving, you will need to buzz security at the white gates.

Using St Joseph's Chapel

Sadly we cannot restart the Mass in St Joseph's on a Sunday morning until the social distance rules are relaxed. Hopefully after 19th July.

This Sunday

Is the 14th Sunday of Ordinary Time. The gospel recalls how Jesus got a mixed reception when he preached in the synagogue at Nazareth. From today, parishioners can attend the 11am Sunday Mass in person.

Weekday Masses
