First Holy Communions

Two children from SMH will make their First Holy Communion at the 5.30pm Vigil Mass and two St Joseph's Children will make theirs at the 9.30am Sunday Mass. Each family is restricted to 5 family members. The 9.30 Mass this week will be live streamed so that other family members can take part. Please pray for these children.

The 11am Mass

This Sunday the 11am Mass will **not** be open for parishioners to attend. One "bubble" of students will be present in St Peter's. Other bubbles will be watching the Mass streamed to them in different parts of the college. Last Sunday 55 Poetry students were in church with 214 watching on line.

Weekday Masses are Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday at 8am in St Peter's. On Thursdays Fr Tim streams a Mass for the Students of SMH. Alas, at the moment, this is not open to parishioners.
