'Remembrance Sunday'

Next Sunday, November 12th, is the day when we remember in gratitude, and pray for the repose of the souls of those who have given their lives in the two World Wars and subsequent conflicts defending our freedoms.

As well as remembering the dead at masses next weekend, all are encouraged to attend the annual Remembrance Service at the Hurst Green War Memorial, assembling for the Parade at the Village Hall at 10.30am. The Service begins with the traditional two-minute silence at 11.00am.

A propos of Remembrance Sunday, you may wish to know that Bishop Arnold will be offering mass in the Cathedral of St John in Salford at 7.30pm on Friday, 10th November to commemorate the Centenary of the ending of the battle of Passchendaele which raged from 31st July to 10th November 1917.

After the mass, a special exhibition will be launched which is dedicated to the approximately 8,000 men from the Diocese of Salford who sacrificed their lives during the Great War.
