Coming to St Peter's for Mass:

Even as we come out of lockdown, it is important to stick to the following guidelines:

- + Do not come to church if you are unwell, self-Isolating, shielding or returning from a country where you have to quarantine
- + You should wear a face covering
- + Sanitise your hands on the way in and way out
- + Observe the one way system
- + Observe social distancing make sure there is an empty bench between you and anyone else in the Church and keep away from the centre aisle.
- + Any printed materials you touch (Newsletters etc) place in a bin or take home with you.
- + Observe social distancing as you come into church, as you come forward for communion and, very importantly as you leave the church. If you are driving, you will need to buzz security at

the white gates.

This Sunday

Is the feast of Corpus Christi, where we celebrate the greatest gift Jesus could give to the church, the gift of himself.

As pupils from the college will still be on halfterm parishioners may attend the 11am in person, but sadly it will not be livestreamed.

Weekday Masses

Mass will take place on Tuesday, Wednesday as usual. On Friday at 8am the Mass will be replaced by a communion service.

Return to school

After their half term break, pupils from St Joseph's, SMH and the College return to school on Monday. They still have some catching up to do after lockdown, so please pray for them.

Feast of the Sacred Heart (Friday)

Devotion to the Sacred Heart began with a series of visions given to St Margaret Mary Alacoque. Her Spiritual Director was St Claude de la Colombiere, a Jesuit priest. Through their efforts this devotion has spread throughout the world.

Next Sunday

Is the 11th Sunday of Ordinary Time. Ordinary time continues until the Feast of Christ the King in November. The gospel from Mark Jesus explains about the mystery of the Kingdom of God

The 11am Mass

Next Sunday the 11 am Mass will be for pupils only. However, we are hoping to live stream this Mass for parishioners.

Fr Tim Away

Fr Tim will be away on his annual retreat from Wednesday to the following Thursday. During his absence the weekday Masses will be replaced with communion services. Next Sunday Fr Brendan Callaghan SJ will celebrate the Vigil and Sunday Masses. Next Saturday there will NOT be benediction at 5.15pm.

Changes to the rules now in force.

Recently announced changes to regulations include:

- *A soloist or a choir of up to six people may now sing in church
- *Bidding prayers may now be read at Mass
- *The number permitted for funerals goes up from 30 to the safe 2 metres distancing capacity of the church (for St Peter's this is 130 people)
- *The number permitted to attend baptisms and weddings remains at 30

We hope all restrictions will end on 21st June.
