For the time being, the 11am Mass in St Peter's is still available to parishioners. The Mass will be streamed for SMH and College pupils, but they won't be physically in the church. Arrangements are being made for them to receive communion after Mass. Until there is a further easing of the lockdown, pupils from the College will not be in St Peter's at the same time as parishioners.
