Who was St Leo Mangin SJ

Leo Mangin was a French Jesuit sent to China as a missionary in 1875. He is one of 120 Christians now recognized as the "China Martyrs". The upheaval in China was caused by the Boxer Revolution. Fr Mangin and four other Jesuits were amongst those martyred. They were canonized by Pope John Paul II in 2000.
