Prayers Please

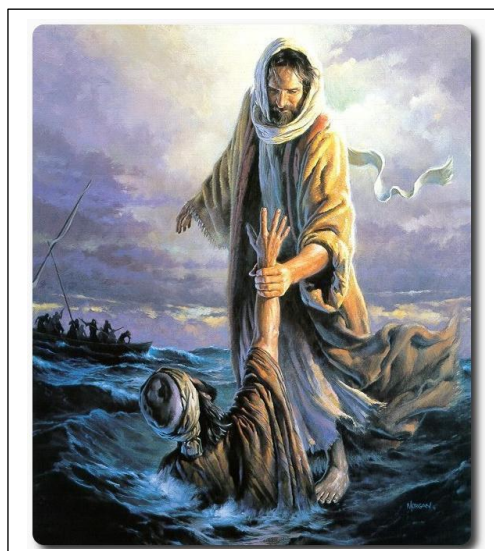
