'A Prophet for our Day' - Lenten Talks and Discussions - 7th, 14th, 21st & 28th March 2017 From Fr Griffiths:

Each year since I have been here, I have suggested and conducted a four-session talk and discussion programme during each Lent. Lent, this year, 2017, is no exception and I am suggesting four sessions on the theme of **prophecy**. Why? Immediately after our baptism, our heads were anointed with Chrism, a special oil, and we were anointed into the Kingly, (or Queenly), Priestly and Prophetic roles of Christ. The authority role and priestly role of our calling is often accepted and understood, but perhaps we lack clarity as to how we can be prophets in our day. The four sessions will help us to consider this role. The need for the prophetic voice is acute at this moment of our history!! More news later.
