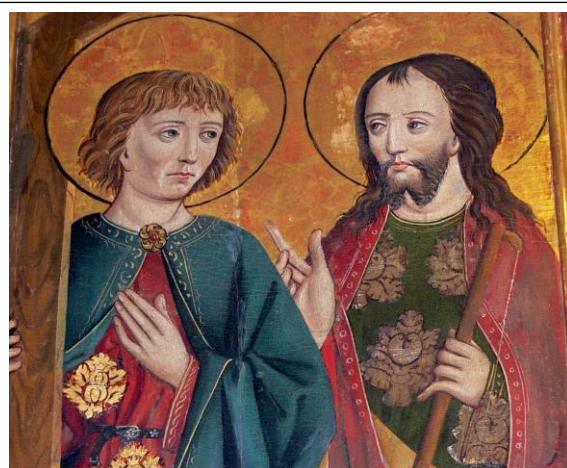
The 9.30am Sunday Mass livestream link
