## Coming to St Peter's for Mass:

Please adhere to the following guidelines:

- + Do not come to church if you are unwell, self-Isolating, shielding or returning from a country where you have to quarantine
- + You should wear a face covering
- + Sanitise your hands on the way in and way out
- + Observe the one way system
- + Observe social distancing make sure there is an empty bench between you and anyone else in the Church and keep away from the centre aisle.
- + Any printed materials you touch (Newsletters etc) place in a bin or take home with you.
- + Observe social distancing as you come into church, as you come forward for communion and, very importantly as you leave the church. If you are driving, you will need to buzz security at the white gates.

## **Using St Joseph's Chapel**

Sadly we cannot restart the Mass in St Joseph's on a Sunday morning until the social distance rules are relaxed.

#### **This Sunday**

Is the 12th Sunday of Ordinary Time. In the gospel Jesus calms a storm.

#### The 11am Mass

This Sunday the 11 am Mass will be for pupils only. It will not be livestreamed.

## **Weekday Masses**

Mass at 8am takes place in St Peter's on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday.

#### **Club Day**

This year St Peter's Club is celebrating their annual feast day, starting with Mass in St Peter's at 10am on Saturday. Ribble Valley Council has given permission for the Longridge Band to play and march down the Avenue socially distanced. Members can leave from in front of the clubhouse at 9.30am on Saturday.

#### **Next Sunday**

Is the 13<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time. In the Gospel, Jesus has to multi-task as two people need his help at the same time. Next Sunday there will be a second collection for Peter's Pence.

#### St Peter and St Paul

Falls on Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> June. There will be a vigil Mass on the Monday evening at 5.30pm in St Peter's for parishioners. The 8.30am Mass in St Peter's will be for College students only. There will be an 11am Mass in St Joseph's School playground which parishioners may join.

## Weddings here at St Peter's

We were hoping that restrictions would ease for the weddings booked for July. However, there is an exemption for weddings, so we can have up to 130 guests in St Peter's. The wedding service may include a soloist or a small choir of up to 6 singers. However, at the moment, congregational singing in not allowed.
