Some doubly vaccinated members of staff have caught Covid recently, and some were quite sick. So it is wise that we err on the side of caution for the time being. It will no longer be against the law if you don't wear a face mask in church, but I hope everyone will continue to do so for everyone's protection.

We no longer have a one way system in church and we can reuse missalettes.

Usual Mass times are as follows:

Saturday

4.30pm Church opens (with exposition)

5.15pm Benediction

5.30pm Mass in St Peter's

Sunday

9.00am Church opens

9.30am Mass in St Joseph's11.00am Mass in St Peter's

Confessions will be available during Holy Hour.

Coming to Mass:

It is still important to adhere to the following guidelines:

- + Do not come to church if you are unwell, self-Isolating, shielding or returning from a country where you have to quarantine
- + You are advised to wear a face covering
- + Sanitise your hands on the way in and way out
- + You may now enter and exit the church through either door. You will no longer be required to keep to the one-way system.
- + Be mindful of those who want to keep their distance and don't "invade" their space.
- + It is now safe to share printed materials, so you may return the missalette after use.
- + Observe social distancing as you come forward for communion.

If you are driving to Stonyhurst, you will need to buzz security at the white gates.

Confessions

Will be available during holy hour, but, where possible, to be celebrated outdoors.

The 5.30pm Vigil Mass

This Mass is being celebrated by Fr Nick King and will mark the beginning of the Stonyhurst Virtual Lourdes Pilgrimage. The Mass is being live streamed (a link on the parish website). Parishioners who would like to take part in other pilgrimage events are welcome to do so.

The 9.30am Sunday Mass

This Mass has returned to St Joseph's. So far numbers have been manageable so that we can all socially distance. Chairs are put out as people arrive, so that we can distance bubbles. Some may prefer to continue coming to St Peter's where there is more ventilation and more space.

The 11am Mass

Is open to parishioners until September.

This Sunday

Is the 21st Sunday of Ordinary Time. In the gospel some of the hearers of Jesus find his teaching too difficult and decide to go away. The twelve remain faithful.
