Pope Francis' call to synodality

Pope Francis has invited every diocese in the world to convoke a synod to discuss the future direction of the Catholic Church. Unlike the 2nd Vatican Council in the 1960's where just the bishop's attended, it is hoped that everyone - bishops, priests and lay people - will have a voice in the Synod process. The results of each synod will be sent to Rome next year and collated for a meeting in Rome planned for 2023.
