
Prayers please

What is a Provincial Visitation?

The Provincial Visitation is *not* like an OFSTED inspection. He will not be grading us on what we do. Rather he will gather information and work out how he and the province can support us so that our work will bear even more fruit. It is also his job to allocate individual Jesuits to the apostolates they are given. He uses the information he gathers at his visitation to assign Jesuits to their communities and their apostolates. As the number of Jesuits in the province continues to diminish, this work is made even harder.

As Fr Peter visits our schools and parishes next week, let's make him feel welcome and assist him in his task. We can pray for him!
