Weekday Masses

Mass will take place on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday at 8am in St Peter's. Tuesday and Wednesday are special feast days.

Coming to St Peter's for Mass:

Since the new strain of the virus is so virulent, we need to take extra care:

- + Do not come to church if you are unwell, self-Isolating, shielding or returning from a country where you have to quarantine
- + You should wear a face covering
- + Observe the one way system
- + Observe social distancing make sure there are 2 empty benches between you and anyone else in the Church and away from the centre aisle.
- + Any printed materials you touch (Newsletters etc) place in a bin or take home with you.
- + Observe social distancing as you come into church, as you come forward for communion and, very importantly as you leave the church. We have to assume that someone is carrying the virus and take precautions.

If you are driving, you will need to buzz security at the white gates.

Those who are shielding:

Should **NOT** come to church.

This Sunday

Is the 4rd Sunday of Ordinary Time. In the gospel Jesus performs his first miracle in Capernaum. The people begin to realise that he has a special mission from God.

Feast days this week

Tuesday is the feast of the Presentation of the child Jesus in the Temple. The 8am Mass will begin with a blessing of candles.

Wednesday is the feast of St Blaise. The 8am Mass will conclude with a blessing of throats. Both of these ceremonies will be conducted in a covid safe way.

Next Sunday

Is the 5th Sunday of Ordinary Time. The gospel gives an account of a typical day in the life of Jesus.
