

## End of the Ignatian Year

Today marks the end of the Ignatian Year, to celebrate the 500<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the conversion of St Ignatius.

Last year on the 20<sup>th</sup> May we began the year by remembering the battle of Pamplona, where Ignatius was injured when a cannon ball hit his leg. Here at Stonyhurst we fired the cannons at the Lyons to mark this historic moment. Subsequently he was carried to Loyola where, in his family's castle, he underwent a long and painful recovery. There he discovered the Lord. He spent time in a cave in Manresa, where he began to write down his experiences in a book that became his *Spiritual Exercises*. Now he begins his mission to "help souls" by using the method he has learnt to inflame others

using the method he has learnt to inflame others with a love of God and a determination to find God's will. Eventually, when he gathered some friends together in Paris, the Society of Jesus would be born.
