### Today

We celebrate the feast of All Saints. We begin the month of November by honouring those who have won victory by their lives here on earth. The 11am Sunday Mass will be for the Stonyhurst and SMH students finishing their half-term camp.

### The 11am Mass

This Sunday the 11am Mass will **not** be open for parishioners to attend. Most students are on their half term break, but some have remained for a camp. Due to lock downs in their countries, other have returned early. The Mass will be just for them.

### Feast of All Souls

Monday is the feast of All Souls and we normally have a Mass in the chapel of St Joseph's Cemetery. We cannot do this this year and observe social distancing. Instead the Mass will take place on Monday at **10.30am in St Peter's**. At the end of the Mass you will be given a candle and some holy water to bless your family grave.
