From the Parish Priest.

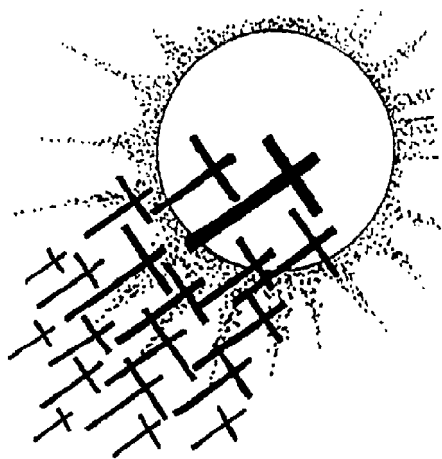
I shall be away for a late summer holiday from Friday, September 15th until Friday, September 29th.
