

#### **Today**

Is Trinity Sunday. We rejoice in the knowledge of the fullness of God's revelation. Fr Tim will say Mass in St Peter's at 5.30 pm on Saturday and in St Joseph's at 9.30 am on Sunday.

#### **Return to School**

Neither SMH nor St Joseph's were able to open last week. The hope is that classes will resume for some pupils this coming week. Keep them and their teachers in your prayers. Stonyhurst is continuing to teach all students on line.

#### **Saints this week**

Monday is the feast of St James Berthieu, a French Jesuit Missionary to Madagascar, who was martyred in 1896. The first Madagascan saint.

#### **Next Sunday**

Is the feast of Corpus Christi. We have not been able to come to Mass and receive communion for some time. On this feast day let us be aware of our hunger for these sacraments.

#### **Box by the Cenotaph**

Contains daily reflections and current booklets that are usually available at the back of the church. This week there are some copies of the *Jesuits and Friends* magazine.

#### **Statistics**

Last week we delivered 120 copies of the newsletter (thanks to those who deliver them) and 98 people accessed it on line. 8 people took printed copies of the daily reflections and 22 people read these on line!

#### **Book of remembrance and prayer**

Many people have sent in names for the book of remembrance and prayer for those connected with the parish and the Stonyhurst/SMH community who are sick or who have passed away. If you would like some names to be added to this book, let Fr Tim know. They will be remembered at Mass every day.

#### **Cards from the piety stall**

While the repository is closed, there is a small selection of cards available in the parish box by the cenotaph.

#### **Preparing for the reopening of churches**

It looks like churches will not be open for Mass until July. If permission is granted, St Peter's will be open for private prayer, but with a Covid-19 risk assessment in place. It will not be possible to open the church all day, every day, so we will publish a schedule indicating when it will be open for prayer. The Diocese of Salford intends to open churches gradually, with one or two churches per deanery open for prayer. It is essential that this does not contribute to a second spike so social distancing and cleaning measures will be in place. Watch this space!
