Hopefully in just over a week's time we can begin to relax restrictions. Until then we will continue with our covid-safe procedures in place. Coming to St Peter's for Mass:

Please adhere to the following guidelines:

- + Do not come to church if you are unwell, self-isolating, shielding or returning from a country where you have to quarantine
- + You should wear a face covering
- + Sanitise your hands on the way in and way out
- + Observe the one way system
- + Observe social distancing – make sure there is an empty bench between you and anyone else in the Church and keep away from the centre aisle.
- + Any printed materials you touch (Newsletters etc) place in a bin or take home with you.
- + Observe social distancing as you come into church, as you come forward for communion and, very importantly as you leave the church.

If you are driving, you will need to buzz security at the white gates.

Using St Joseph's Chapel

Sadly we cannot restart the Mass in St Joseph's on a Sunday morning until the social distance rules are relaxed. Hopefully the 9.30am Mass will be back in St Joseph's on Sunday 25th July.
