### Coming to St Peter's to pray

(Saturday 4.00pm to 5.15pm)

- + Do not come if you are unwell or shielding
  - + **You should wear a face covering**
  - + Sanitize your hands on entering and leaving
  - + Follow the one way system
  - + Observe social distancing from others
  - + The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed.
- If you are driving, you will need to buzz security at the white gates. The Lodge entrance is closed.

### Coming to St Peter's to Mass

- + Do not come to Mass if you are unwell, self-isolating or shielding
- + **You should wear a face covering**
- + Observe the one way system
- + Observe social distancing
- + Any printed materials you touch (Newsletters etc) place in a bin or take home with you.
- + You may wish to come to a weekday Mass instead of on Saturday or Sunday. This will fulfill your Sunday obligation.

### At Mass

- + There will be no homily or bidding prayers (these will be printed so you can take them)
- + Sadly we cannot have any singing
- + There will be no sign of peace
- + Communion will be given only on the hand

### Today

Is the 16<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time. The gospel is the parable of the darnel (weeds) being planted alongside the good seed.

### Weekday Mass

Weekday Masses take place in St Peter's on **Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday** at 8am.

- + The church will open at 7.30am
- + Mass will be from the main altar
- + The church will close after Mass.

### Feasts in the week

Wednesday is the feast of St Mary Magdalen, the first to meet Jesus in the resurrection.

### Next Sunday

Is the 17<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time. The gospel asks us to reflect on how important our faith is?

Last weekend was a wonderful experience for many. As we now have Mass, few people came to pray in St Peter's in the early afternoon. From this weekend, St Peter's will open for private prayer from **4pm**. People are quickly getting used to the new way of going to Mass.
