This Sunday

Is the 13th Sunday of Ordinary Time. We are back to green vestments. In the gospel Jesus talks about some obstacles to the call to preach the Good News.

Benediction

Takes place in St Peter's before the 5.30pm Vigil Mass. For this half term the boarders will join us.

The 11am Mass

Feast of St Peter and St Paul

Falls on Wednesday. There will be a vigil Mass just for parishioners at 5.30pm on Tuesday. On Wednesday, the 8.30am Mass is in SMH, the 11.30am Mass is in St Peter's for the College, and the 2.30pm Mass is in St Joseph's. Parishioners may come to any of these celebrations.

Fr Tim – health update

Fr Tim has been diagnosed with an aggressive form of prostate cancer. The nuclear body scan revealed that the cancer has not spread to the bones or lymph nodes – which is good news. He has now begun a course of Hormone Therapy, designed to shrink the tumour. In about 3 months' time he will have to undergo some radio therapy, which is likely to have some side effects. For the time being, at least, he can continue with his schedule of Masses, weddings, baptisms etc. However, further down the line, he may have to replace some Masses with communion services. Thanks for your prayers and offers of help.

The provincial has asked if Fr Vincent Vaz SJ from India can come to Stonyhurst during August for a mini-Sabbatical. A very timely visit! He will be able to help with Masses. He doesn't have his visa yet, so keep your fingers crossed.
